LONDON → TUNIS (3H)

This ancient trading hub remains a source of riches for all who visit.

At the tip of North Africa lies one of the ancient world's most powerful cities: Carthage. In its strategic position on the Mediterranean, it has hosted empire after empire. It is flanked by the capital city of Tunis with its labyrinthine old medina, lavishly decorated kasbahs and mosques. After settling in, join your fellow guests for dinner accompanied by a local jazz band. The next morning, explore ancient Carthage's remarkable

archaeological sites, including the Punic Port, the Baths of Antoninus and the Cisterns of La Malga. Delve into the old medina of Tunis and be gloriously immersed in the ancient backstreets and alleyways harboring market stalls of curios and crafts, cafés and hammams, historic palaces and mosques. Back in Carthage for sunset, the walled citadel of Byrsa is the extraordinary setting for the evening's scenic cocktail reception, followed by dinner at your restaurant of choice. A landscape of boundless golden savannas studded with spindly acacias, where elephants gather at watering holes, grazing herds keep a watchful eye and the air-splitting roar of a lion sounds from dawn to dusk — this is the Maasai Mara, the crown jewel of East Africa. Following an overnight in Nairobi, travel to the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust for a private visit with rescued elephants

and their keepers, where an orphaned elephant is adopted on your behalf. Continue via charter flight to the Maasai Mara to observe its amazing variety of wildlife, including the iconic Big Five: lions, elephants, leopards, rhinos and Cape buffalo. Explore on game drives, a bush walk and an early morning balloon safari, complete with a private champagne breakfast in the bush. You may also visit a Maasai village to meet the nomadic herders who still act as stewards of this land. Witness the impact of A&K Philanthropy with a stop at a local school, where you are the guests of honor at a ribbon-cutting ceremony for a school improvement project. 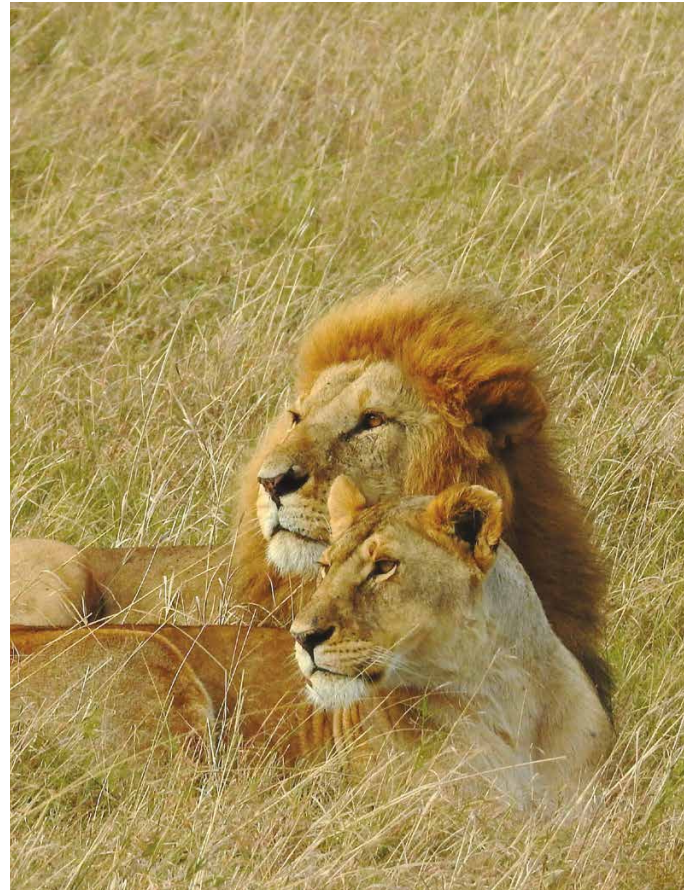

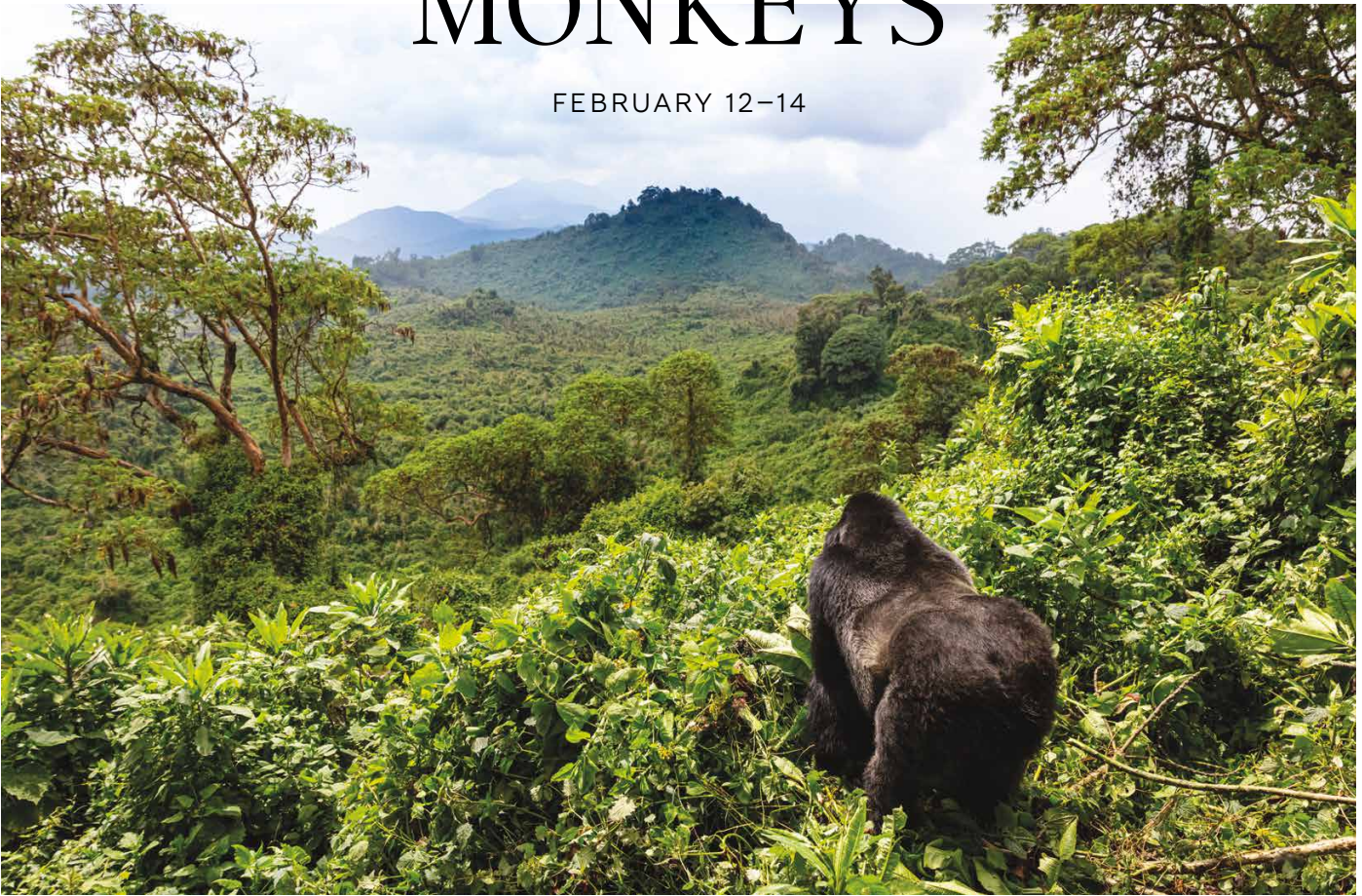

Departing the plains of the Maasai Mara, your next stop is a dense tropical jungle, its air ringing with the call of birds and the buzzing of insects, its trees harboring some of the rarest life on earth — including some of our closest primate relatives. From Musanze, your gateway to Volcanoes National Park, set out on your once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to

encounter some of the jungle's mountain gorillas, part of a worldwide population of only 1,000. Spend an hour in the company of these magnificent creatures as they forage, play or simply lounge amid the greenery, their affinity to humans apparent in every interaction and glance. 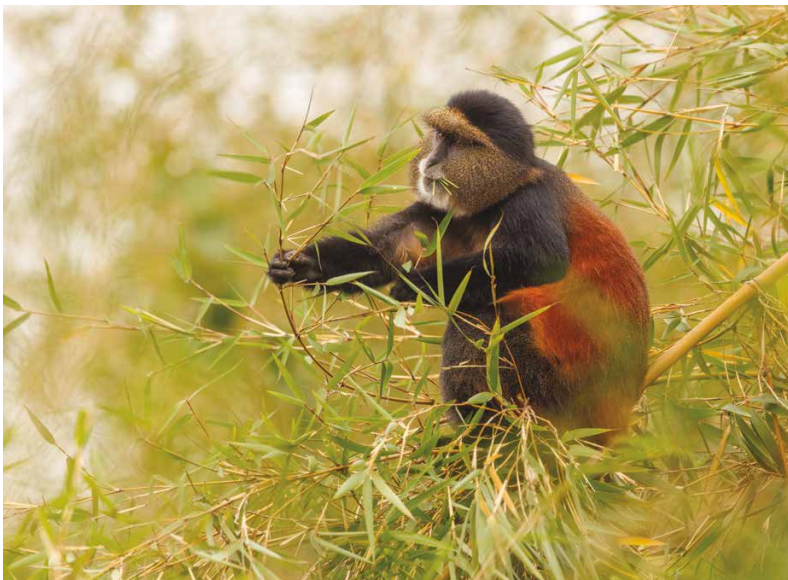

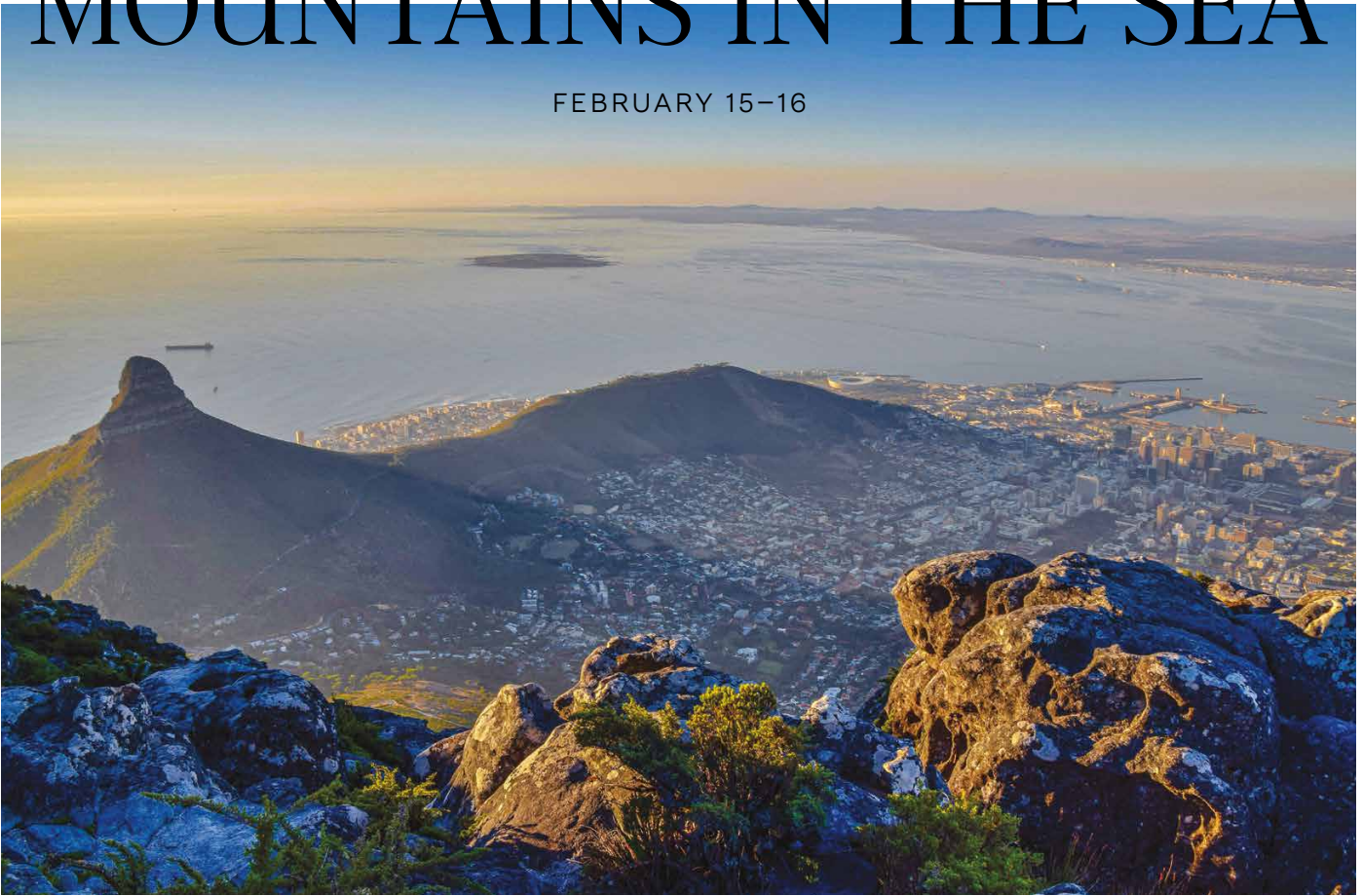

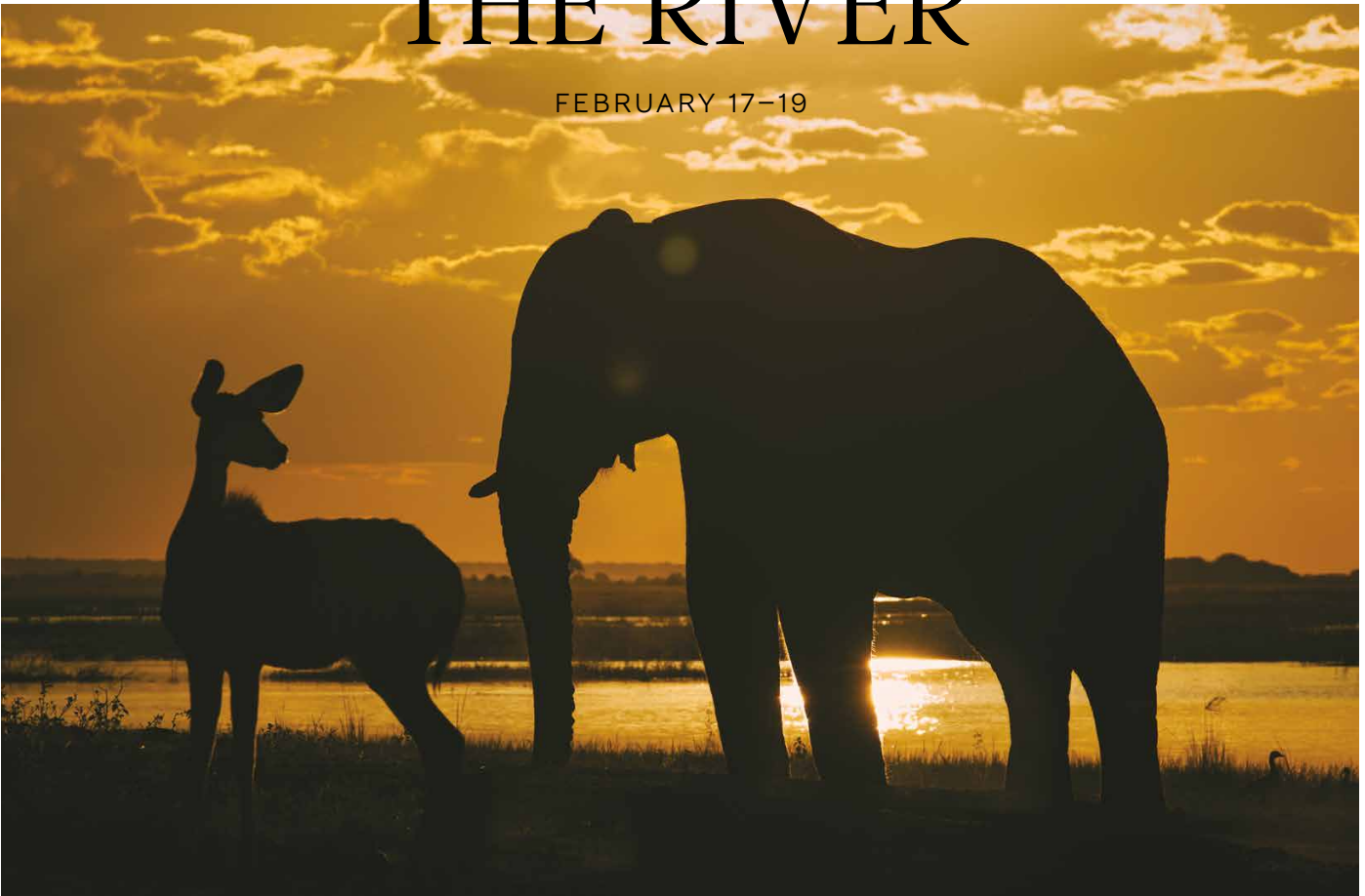

A brief coda to your Cape Town visit finds you ascending Table Mountain by cable car for one last view of this beautiful city and its extraordinary setting. As natural spectacles go, it's just a warm-up to Victoria Falls, a mile-wide cliff perpetually wreathed in spray from its thundering cascades. See the falls

up close from the Zimbabwean side before a scenic drive to Botswana's Chobe National Park and your accommodation at Chobe Game Lodge. In addition to some of the largest elephant herds on the continent, the Chobe plain is home to buffalo, giraffes, kudus and hippos, as well as predators such as lions and leopards. Between game drives, relax in one of the lounges, take a dip in the pool or stake out a spot on one of the viewing decks to watch the ever-changing wildlife parade across the river. Head out for a unique sundowner safari experience in the evening, cruising down the Chobe River with a cocktail in hand. *Meals: B L D*

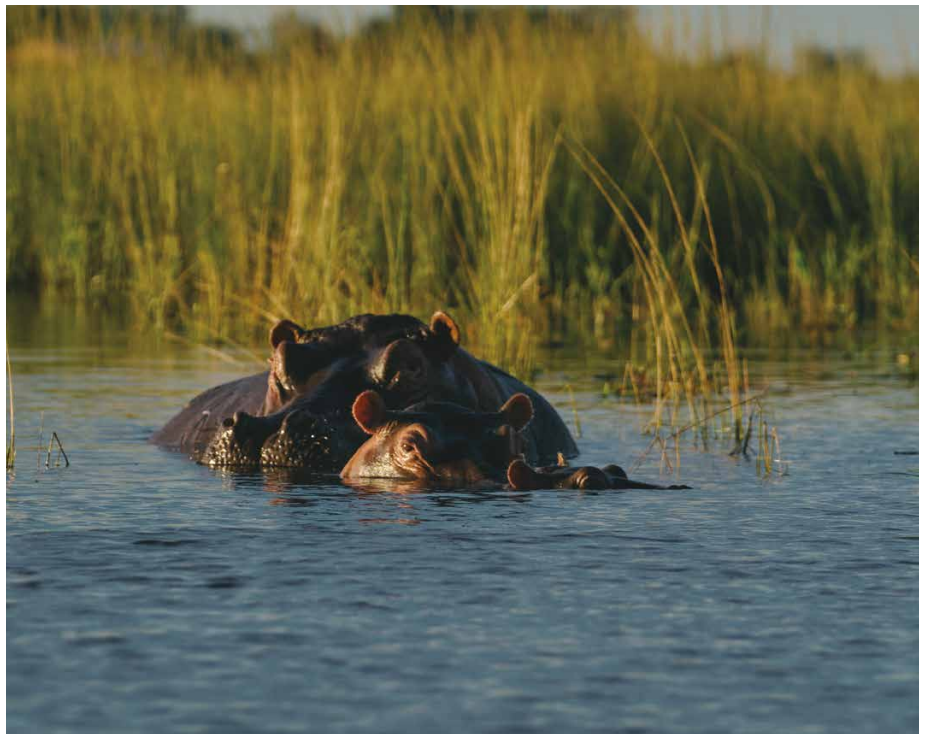

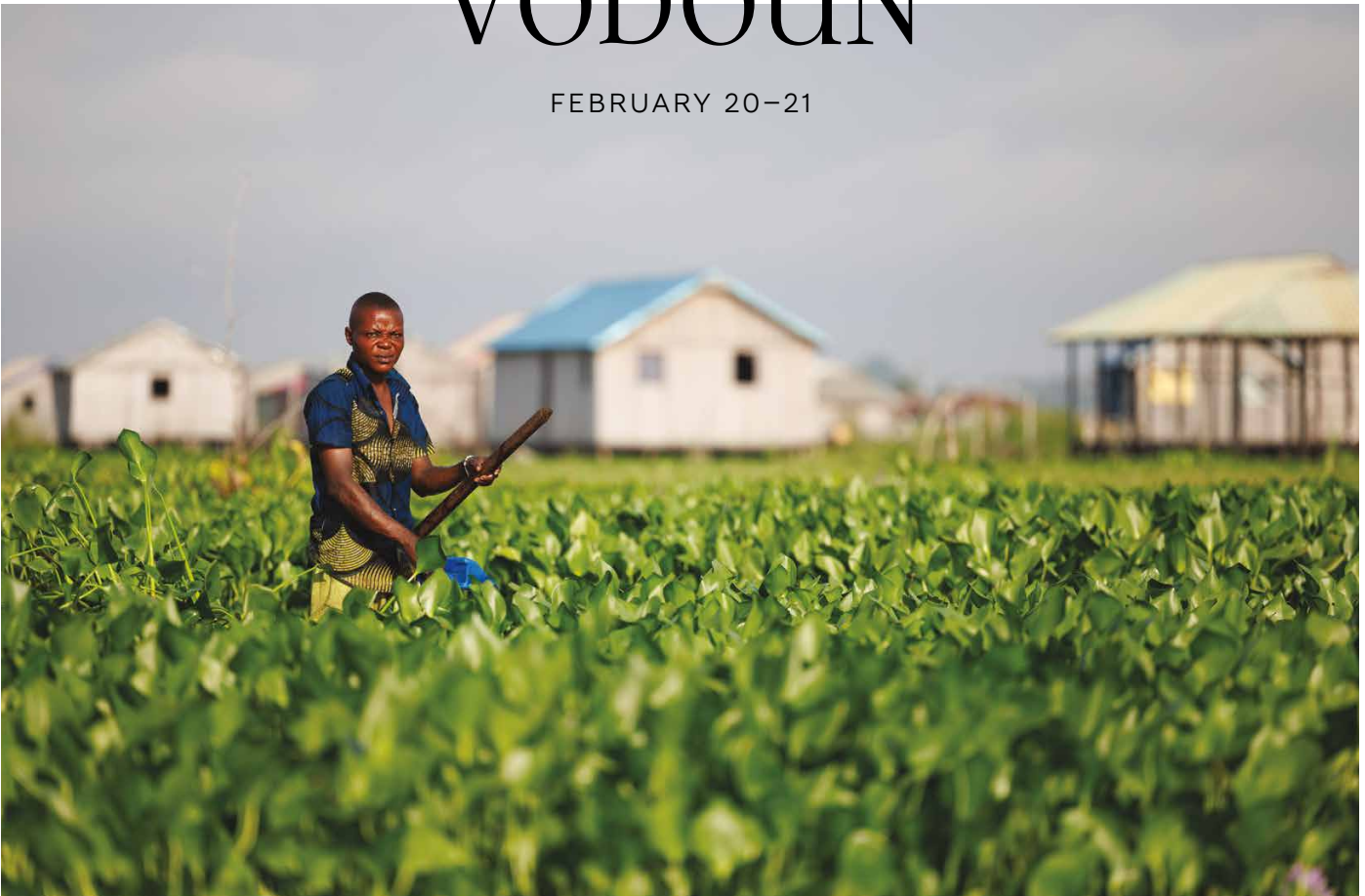

VICTORIA FALLS → COTONOU (4H 30M)

A long-misunderstood faith is revealed for you in all its authentic wonder.

Far from most travellers' radar, Benin is a West African crossroads of busy markets, palm-lined beaches and a spiritual tradition unlike any other. Cotonou, the vibrant capital of Benin, greets you with a rousing display of traditional drumming, singing, and dancing. Explore Ganvie, a remarkable village

on water where vendors in dugout canoes piled high with goods conduct a brisk trade. Settle in for a relaxing canoe ride through the waterways of this exotic 300-year-old community, where a band and dance troupe welcome you. In Ouidah, one of the epicenters of African Vodoun, delve into the origins of this spiritual tradition, born in West Africa and carried to the Americas through the slave trade. Attend an authentic Vodoun ceremony, and then visit the temple dedicated to the sacred python, revered for its power to bestow vitality and protection, and then roam through the Sacred Forest. *Meals: B L D*

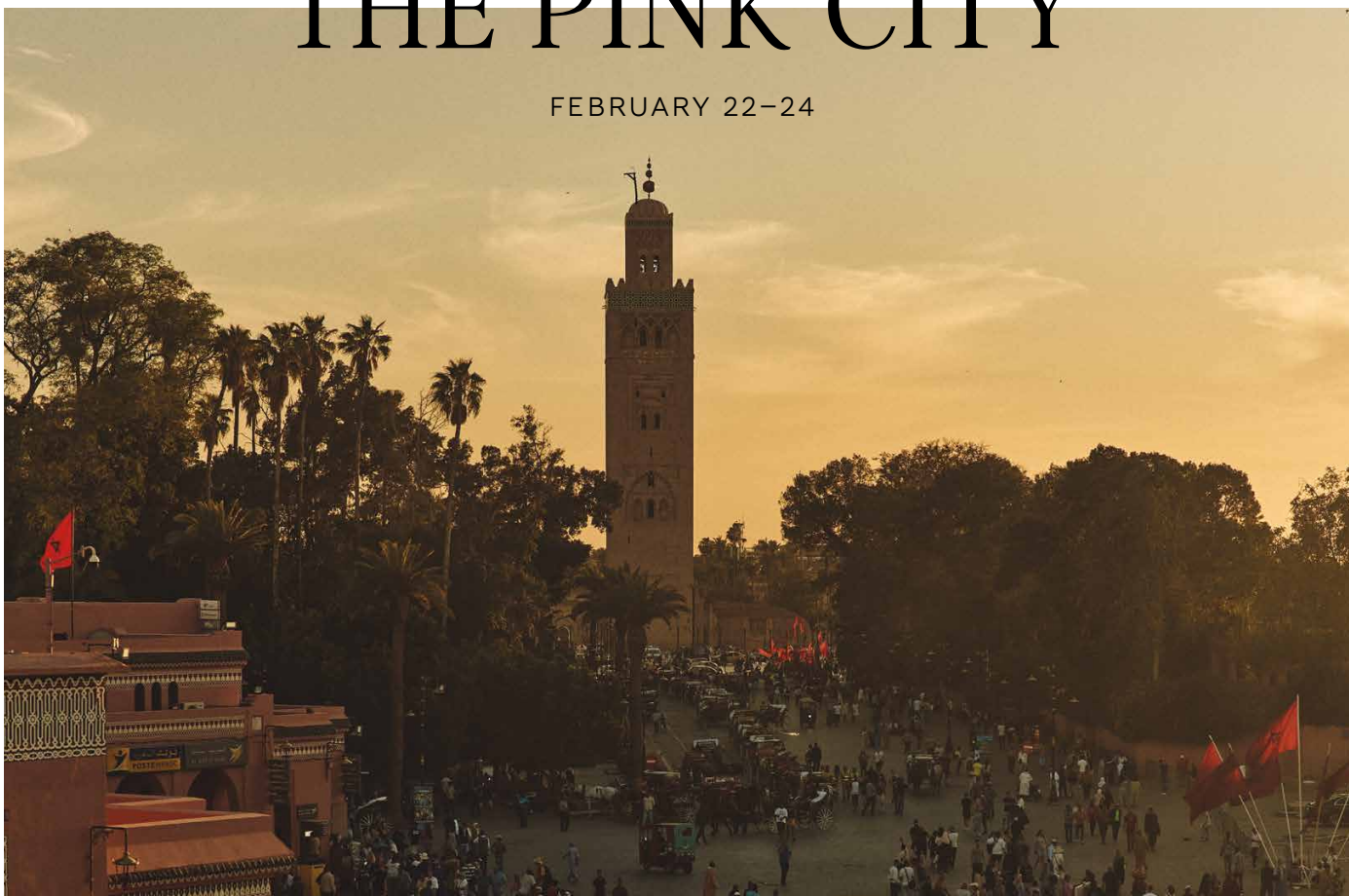

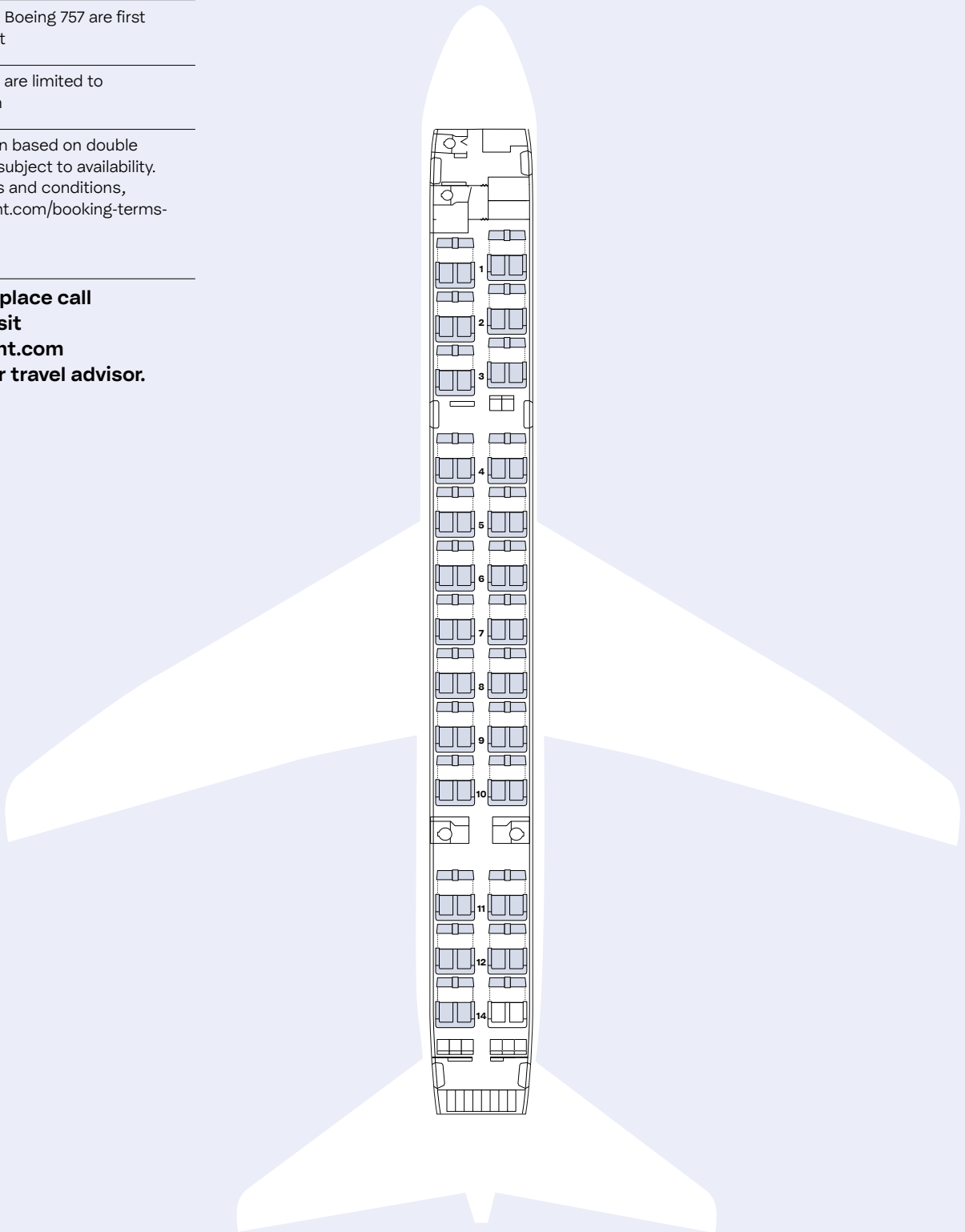
